As soon as you arrive, you see the huge plastic domes called 'biomes'. The two biggest biomes are the Rainforest Biome and the Mediterranean Biome. The Rainforest Biome has a warm climate, with plants from parts of Asia, Africa and South America. The Mediterranean Biome has over 1,000 different plants from countries around the Mediterranean Sea and from California and South Africa.

The Eden Project also has outdoor gardens with plants and flowers you can use for medicine, fuel and food. Groups of school children regularly visit and there are courses for adults about plants and nature.
